### **1. Cassian Andor**

One of the Rebellion's top intelligence officers, Cassian Andor carries out missions that demand secrecy, sacrifice, and split-second judgment. From high-level assassinations to deep-cover espionage, his work rarely leaves room for hesitation. Cassian's strength lies in his ability to navigate grey zones, both ethically and tactically, while never losing sight of the greater cause. His field experience and emotional restraint make him indispensable.

### **2. Jyn Erso**

Known for her leadership, Jyn Erso played a critical role in several early rebel victories. Once a fugitive, she rose to become one of the Rebellion's most daring operatives. Although she operates without a formal rank, Jyn's natural defiance and moral clarity allow her to rally others in moments of crisis. Her role in high-risk operations have earned her symbolic status among insurgents.

### **3. Chirrut Îmwe**

A blind warrior-monk trained in ancient martial disciplines, Chirrut Îmwe is known for his unmatched reflexes and spiritual focus. Although not traditionally force-sensitive, his firm belief in the force serves as a guiding principle. Often seen on the frontlines, Chirrut uses a combination of staff combat and heightened senses to neutralize enemy forces with surgical efficiency.

### **4. Luthen Rael**

A mysterious figure who operates under multiple aliases, Luthen Rael quietly orchestrates rebel actions from behind the scenes. He maintains a network of spies, mercenaries, and informants which spread across multiple sectors throughout the galaxy. While his motives remain unclear, Luthen is known for manipulating events to push the Rebellion against the Empire.



## **5. Baze Malbus**

Heavily armed and highly trained, Baze Malbus is a frontline combatant notorious for his use of heavy repeater rifles and anti-vehicle weapons. While being skeptical of spiritual ideologies, he remains consistent with his beliefs of direct military action to get the job done, proven by his victories on the battlefield. Baze's battlefield presence has proven vital in missions requiring sustained firepower and area control.

## **6. Mon Mothma**

A founding voice of dissent within the Imperial Senate, Mon Mothma serves as the political heart of the Rebel Alliance. She works tirelessly to secure funding and shape strategic objectives across systems. While she remains a current Imperial Senator in the public eye, her private defiance is relentless. Moreover, she is noted as one of the earliest and most vocal of her time, using her diplomatic ties and oratory skills to help unite multiple cells under a single cause.

## **7. Saw Gerrera**

A veteran of the Clone Wars and early insurgent against the Empire, Saw Gerrera leads the Partisans, an extremist cell operating rather independently of the Rebel Alliance. Saw is known for his brutal tactics, revolving around assaults and intimidation. Though many in the Rebellion distance themselves from him, Saw's success in disrupting Imperial operations have made him impossible to ignore.

## **8. Admiral Raddus**

A fleet commander from Mon Cala, Admiral Raddus leads rebel assaults against the Empire. Known for his aggressive tactics and willingness to commit resources without approval, His style is fast-moving, aggressive, and often unilateral, but his victories are hard to dispute. Raddus plays a direct role in the escape of critical intelligence. His leadership is credited as he remains admirable in turning battles in his favor.



## **9. Bix Caleen**

Once embedded in Ferrix's black-market circuits, Bix Caleen provides logistical support and intelligence to anti-Imperial operations. Her background in networking and technical skills makes her a valuable asset in covert operations, as her years of navigating underground channels have made her a skilled handler of secrets. Her operations continue despite persistent Imperial surveillance and increasing personal risk.

## **10. K-2SO**

Originally an Imperial security droid, K-2SO has been reprogrammed into a loyal and highly capable operative of rebel intelligence. He is notably equipped with advanced combat protocols, slicing capabilities, and high-level threat analysis. Known for his blunt communication style, K-2SO provides both security and tactical assistance in rebel operations. His presence in a mission typically signals the need for brute force and digital precision alike.

## **11. General Davits Draven**

Tasked with overseeing field operations, General Draven is one of the most results-driven officers in the Rebellion. His command style is blunt and goal-oriented, often placing outcomes above process. Thus, Draven approves orders, sabotage missions, and intelligence raids with little hesitation. Though criticized for his lack of diplomacy, Draven's decisions have resulted in undoubtable gains for rebel intelligence.

## **12. General Merrick**

Leading Rebel starfighter command, General Merrick is an aerial tactician capable of orchestrating split-second countermeasures during live assaults. Known for his ability to coordinate aerial support under chaotic conditions, Merrick provided crucial cover which allowed for ground teams to complete their missions. His leadership remains monumental as the Rebel forces continue to grow.



### **13. Vel Sartha**

An experienced field agent of the Rebellion, Veel Sartha is a trained infiltration operative, tasked with high-level sabotage and independent field assignments. Frequently deployed in hostile territory, she executes operations without oversight or backup. Vel's ability to adapt under pressure makes her invaluable to long-term plans in the Outer Rim. Her secrecy and self-control give her an edge when trust is scarce.

### **14. Cinta Kaz**

With unmatched precision and near-total emotional control, Cinta Kaz is a stealth operative specializing in sabotage and destruction. Often working solo or being dispatched in small units, she enjoys taking on high-risk missions and has participated in various successful interdictions of Imperial supply lines. Her stealth abilities make her difficult for Imperial forces to track down.

### **15. Kleya Marki**

Working behind the scenes of Coruscant's underworld, Kleya Marki manages communication, logistics, and strategy for intensive undercover rebel operations. She manages the allocation of gear, transport, and intelligence with meticulous precision. Her network of contacts spans from politicians to smugglers, giving her leverage across multiple fronts. It is important that her efforts are never traced back to the Alliance for effort to progress.

### **16. Sergeant Ruescott Melshi**

A veteran ground soldier for the Rebellion, Sergeant Melshi has survived and led numerous close-quarters engagements. His background includes prison escapes, frontal assaults, and fierce battles, where morale is scarce and risks are absolute. Melshi's voice carries weight with enlisted ranks, especially in missions without clean exits. He leads from the front, and soldiers follow.



### **17. Aarnis Bhaam**

As a senator from Tyvalon, Aarnis Bhaam uses her diplomatic immunity to funnel classified information into the Rebellion's efforts. She delays surveillance expansion and discreetly reroutes funding through bureaucratic blockades. While her public stance is neutral, her voting record hints at subversion. Her continued presence in the Senate offers vital cover and access for Rebel sympathizers in the Core. Her impact continues to grow as tensions rise.

### **18. Bail Organa**

One of the senior leaders of the early resistance and Imperial Senator, Bail Organa uses his wealth and political stature to discreetly support rebel infrastructure. From supplying arms to sheltering operatives, his involvement has been essential in the Alliance's survival. Admired for his calm-headedness and strong ties in the Core Worlds, Bail's opposition to the Empire assists the Rebellion's political arm.

### **19. Wilmon Paak**

A young, motivated technician from Ferrix, Wilmon Paak contributes to resistance networks through technical sabotage and communication disruptions. Trained by circumstance rather than rank, he uses mechanical skill to cripple local Imperial installations. Aided by his background in mechanics and ability to turn scraps into operative tools, Wilmon's efforts and unique skill set has helped to hinder Imperial operations.

### **20. Davo Sculdun**

A well-connected financier with no overt ideology, Davo Sculdun operates in the grey zone between business and rebellion. He launders credits through shell companies and inheritance loopholes to obscure rebel funding. Being non-politically motivated, he has arranged a number of financial transactions which divert capital from Imperial Control. With his reliability earning him repeated use, Davo's results support high-level insurgency.



## **21. Lonni Jung**

Embedded within the Imperial Security Bureau itself, Lonni Jung risks everything to leak high-value information to the Rebellion. Although his information is limited, he reports on fleet movements, monitoring procedures, and confidential information from the inside. His intel often determines whether Rebel operatives live or die, allowing rebel strategists to plan accordingly.

## **22. Lieutenant Gorn**

Formerly an Imperial officer, Lieutenant Gorn operates as a planted agent feeding strategic access points to Rebel command. He facilitated the high-profile Aldani heist by manipulating troop schedules and supply chains, scoring the rebellion thousands of credits. His knowledge of Imperial procedure and chain of command prove vital to the rebel cause, and his betrayal of the Empire, being deeply personal, makes him dangerous.

## **23. Rishin Jagar**

Once an analyst for the ISB, Rishin Jagar now uses his mastery of encrypted Imperial data to serve the Rebellion from the shadows. Specializing in codebreaking and signal interception, he deciphers Imperial movement with almost surgical precision. Few know his face, but his digital fingerprints are present in nearly every major data-based operation. His reliability stems from his stoic and meticulous nature.

## **24. Tay Kolma**

An independent and discreet finance operative, Tay Kolma is a specialist in legal manipulation, legislative redirection, and covert asset movement. He has assisted in laundering funds for the rebellion via state-owned development banks and legal trusts. While he does not publicly sympathize with the rebel effort, his knowledge in finances makes him a critical source of covert funding.



## **25. Nish Vadal**

Well-known, cybernetically enhanced, and economically untouchable throughout Corulag's industrial base, Nish Vadal is an information broker, having access to encrypted Imperial research and trade data. Nish sells intelligence selectively, often for protection or favors. Though not fully loyal to the Rebellion, his transactions weaken the Imperial industry one shipment at a time. His presence remains tolerated due to his unique reach.

## **26. Carro Rylanz**

A merchant based in Ghorman and developing revolutionary, Carro Rylanz uses commercial contacts to smuggle equipment and information across planetary checkpoints. His ground labor control has created several networks of passive resistance against the Empire, as he coordinated with dockhands and miners to create passive labor slowdowns indirectly bleeding the Empire's efficiency without direct opposition.

## **27. Erskin Semaj**

A popular bureaucrat in the Imperial Senate with access to critical legislation, Erskin Semaj maintains ongoing access to bills and the highest-priority Imperial memos. Erskin has quietly undermined the surveillance efforts of the Empire, discreetly sabotaging Imperial finance tracking, and continues to funnel embezzled funds through insensible channels to the rebellion effort.

## **28. Kivan Murga**

Commander of a rebel cell in Sargrev V, Kivan Murga specializes in high-risk ambushes on Imperial convoys. Kivan is notorious for his quick thinking, usage of terrain, speed, and his low reliance on external support. Kivan's insistence on autonomy makes him unpredictable, but highly effective. His cell is praised for their absolute silence and for conducting operations that are tactically impossible by conforming to approved command.





## **29. Pao**

A fierce and loud-mouthed Drabata commando, Pao is recognized for his ferocity, battle cry, and his refusal to yield under heavy fire on the frontlines. He is always eager for battle, and remains effective in breaking through enemy lines of reactionaries and fortified positions even under the most stressful situations. Pao's presence often energizes troops and destabilizes enemy morale, earning him a reputation for his unwavering resolve.
