1. **Dukey**

Johnny's genetically modified talking dog and loyal best friend, he guides Johnny with logic when chaos erupts. While he has no inherent superpowers, he talks, strategizes, and often helps reverse or contain dangerous experiments. Dukey's key strengths are his loyalty and intelligence. His weakness is being easily distracted and panicking under pressure. He is firmly allied with Johnny and the Test family.

2. **Susan Test**

One of Johnny's genius twin sisters, she leads the creation of advanced technologies and gadgets. She is ambitious, resourceful, and enjoys pushing scientific boundaries, though that ambition sometimes backfires. Her strengths are her intellect and creativity, and her weaknesses include poor eye-sight, impatience, and occasional misuse of her inventions. She is closely allied with Mary and reluctantly with Johnny as his inventor.

3. **Mary Test**

The more cautious and ethical twin of the Test sisters, Mary balances Susan's intensity by insisting on responsible use of science. She is logical, empathetic, and level-headed, though prone to curiosity and grudging involvement in Susan's riskier schemes. Her strengths include compassion and restraint, while weaknesses may include hesitation or being overshadowed by Susan. Mary is always aligned with her sister and family.

4. **Hugh Test**

The neat-obsessed stay-at-home dad who loves cooking meatloaf and enforcing household order. While he has no powers, he acts as caretaker and disciplinarian, trying to maintain order amid scientific chaos. His strengths are commitment, routine, and family devotion, his weaknesses include easily distractible and overreacting to messes. He is allied with Lila and attempts to keep the family safe, though often clueless about the real mess beneath.



5. **Lila Test**

Johnny's career-driven mother and occasional martial artist who balances business responsibilities with family care. She has strong organizational skills, resilience, and loyalty, yet her busy work life sometimes keeps her unaware of her children's experiments. Strengths include discipline, multitasking, and hidden bravery, while a weakness may be being overworked and feeling detached from her family. She allies with Hugh and tries to manage the household quietly.

6. **Dark Vegan:**

An alien vegetarian conqueror from planet Vegandon who briefly threatened Earth. He wields advanced alien technology and boasts a commanding personality, but his overconfidence and dietary extremism make him vulnerable. His strengths are alien resourcefulness, charisma, and sheer ambition, while his weaknesses are pride, poor subtlety, and obsession with toast. He rarely forms alliances, mostly working alone.

7. **Mr. Black**

A government agent tasked with monitoring high-risk situations in Porkbelly, often involving the Test family. He presents himself as the more serious member of his duo, acting as the one in charge, though his decisions are just as questionable as his partner's. His strengths include access to advanced government gadgets, a sense of duty, and unwavering loyalty to his team, while weaknesses include overconfidence, lack of subtlety and an inability to predict consequences. He is permanently partnered with Mr. White and often calls on the Test children for unconventional problem-solving.

8. **Mr. White**



The other half of the government's field team, stationed near Porkbelly. Mr. White tends to be more easygoing and comedic than Mr. Black, often getting distracted or sidetracked during missions. His strengths include adaptability, gadget proficiency, and enthusiasm. His weaknesses include short attention span, clumsiness, and poor planning skills. He remains closely allied with Mr. Black and frequently depends on the Test family's unconventional methods to finish a job.

9. The General

The loud and forgetful commanding officer over Black & White, stationed at Area 51.1. He orders military responses to threats, often escalating problems rather than containing them. Strengths include access to military resources and an unstoppable desire to protect Porkbelly, while weaknesses are forgetfulness, over-the-top actions, and ignoring collateral damage. Though allied with the Test family as unofficial protectors, he frequently unnecessarily complicates missions.

10. Sissy Blakely:

Johnny's competitive schoolmate who covertly likes him behind the teasing and the rivalry. She's athletic, confident, and occasionally helpful in joint problems, but also boastful and stubborn. Her strengths are physical skill and persistence, while her weaknesses are pride, denial of her feelings, and tendency to rub Johnny's nose in defeat. She's loosely allied with Johnny as rival-turned-friend and with her dog Missy.

11. Bumper Randalls

The school bully who frequently torments Johnny but secretly loves gardening and animals. His strengths are toughness, surprising gentleness toward plants, and occasional vulnerability. His weaknesses are cruelty, anger issues, and family expectations. He is adversarial to Johnny and occasionally allied with his pet animals.



12. Mr. Henry Teacherman

Johnny's strict and authoritarian school teacher who seems to enjoy seeing students struggle. He assigns unfair tests and rarely accepts excuses. His strengths are discipline, academic rigor, and consistency, but his weaknesses are stubbornness, lack of empathy, and antagonistic nature toward Johnny. He is aligned with school systems and frequently clashes with the Test children.

13. Gil Nexdor

Susan and Mary's crush and Johnny's blond, oblivious next-door neighbor. Though attractive, he is depicted as intellectually limited and forgetful, he often fails to remember Susan and Mary. His strengths are friendliness, good looks, and oblivious charm, while his weaknesses are his poor intelligence and cluelessness about attention from others. He is friendly with Johnny, but mostly unaware of the sisters' admiration.

14. Professor Slopsink

Head professor at the Porkbelly Institute of Technology, he is a teacher to Susan, Mary, and Bling-Bling Boy. He lost a hand in a student mishap and wears a robotic replacement. His strengths are academic authority, scientific credibility, while his weaknesses are underestimating students and being absent-minded. He is aligned with educational institutions and occasionally supports or grades sister's experiments.

15. Janet Nelson Jr

Johnny's early crush and a popular, somewhat mean girl in early seasons. She is self-centered and dismissive toward Johnny, though she sometimes shows softer sides. Her strengths are popularity, confidence. Her weaknesses are superficiality and quick shifts in relationship dynamics. She appears mostly in season one and is not in an alliance.



16. Hank Anchorman

The energetic news reporter for Porkbelly News who covers Test-related events. He's devoted and will go to extremes for a scoop. His strengths are media access, persistence, and humor. His weakness is his tendency to sensationalize news. He's loosely allied with citizens of Porkbelly and frequently reports on the Test family.

17. Lolo

The Test twins' lab monkey and frequent test subject, gifted mild intelligence by experiments. She is playful, mischievous, and sometimes saves the day. Her strengths are agility, enhanced smarts, and unpredictability. Her weakness is her animal instincts. She is aligned with Susan and Mary's science projects.

18. Tim Burnout

A classmate who transformed his cat, Mr. Mittens, into an evil supervillain using stolen genetic tech. He's lazy but surprisingly inventive. His strengths are technical skill and scheming, while his weaknesses are laziness, poor judgment, and moral ambiguity. He is adversarial to Johnny and the Tests via the Mr. Mittens storyline, but is occasionally an ally to the Test family.

19. Montague

A mouse bent on world domination who occasionally appears as an antagonist or unexpected ally. He is clever and tenacious but often distracted by cheese. His strengths are his wittiness and resourcefulness, while his weaknesses are his small size, obsessions, and unpredictability. His allegiance shifts, sometimes working with Johnny or against him, depending on his goals

20. Mayor Howard



The panicky mayor of Porkbelly who often caves under pressure and quickly switches allegiances when a supervillain arrives. He's in charge of the city but lacks leadership skills, frequently causing more trouble than he resolves. His strengths are his position and willingness to act, while his weaknesses include indecisiveness, fearfulness, and poor judgment. He's technically allied with Porkbelly's citizens, but his shaky loyalty makes him unreliable.

21. Principal Franklin Goode

The principal of Johnny's middle school who genuinely likes Johnny despite the chaos Johnny causes. He often overrides Teacherman's calls for punishment, giving Johnny a second chance, but expects him to uphold his end of any deal in return. His strengths are fairness and empathy, while his weaknesses include his lack of experience and his ability to easily be manipulated by Johnny. He's aligned with the school administration and occasionally helps Johnny navigate through trouble.

22. Repto-Slicer

A mutant lizard created by Bling-Bling Boy that eventually sides with Johnny after being tamed. It has razor-sharp protrusions all over its body and a chainsaw tongue. Its strengths are its natural weaponry and fierce loyalty once befriended, but its weaknesses include impulsive behavior and limited intelligence. It becomes temporarily allied with Johnny but ultimately leaves to live on Planet Razorium.

23. Jillian Vegan

The compassionate daughter of Dark Vegan who rejects her father's conquest plans and befriends Johnny. She possesses alien abilities and advanced Vegandon tech, offering aid in saving Earth. Her strengths are empathy, advanced tech knowledge, and moral clarity, while her weaknesses include emotional conflict with her father and vulnerability in her human friendships. She forms strong alliances with Johnny, Dukey, and the Test sisters.



24. Mrs. Vegan

Dark Vegan's nagging wife, who often complains about her husband's schemes and obsessions. While she has no powers, her strength is her blunt honesty and emotional weight in their family dynamic. Her weakness is her tendency to belittle Dark Vegan without effect. She remains aligned with her husband, but emotionally supports Jillian's more peaceful views.

25. Phobious McPhobe

A germ-obsessed scientist who, after a cleaning mishap, built a lab devoted to fighting germs and eventually helps Johnny and Dukey contain runaway microorganisms. He's meticulous, scientifically skilled, and hygiene-focused, but his obsession with cleanliness and social isolation serve as weaknesses.
